Your accommodations

Visiting Scholar rooms in Owen Hall are single rooms with one bathroom. These rooms are designed for one person and are not intended to accommodate more people.

Room Amenities:

- Alarm clock
- Elevated bed
- Air conditioning
- Television with cable service
- Internet service in room and throughout Owen Hall
- Desk, desk chair, and dresser underneath the bed
- Mattress, blanket, pillow, pillowcase, flat sheet, fitted sheet, and towels
- Microwave and small refrigerator with **no** freezer included (4 cubic ft.)
- Facilities will tidy up your room Monday, Wednesday, and Friday

Owen Hall Amenities:

- **Every floor:** Study lounges
- **1st floor lobby:** ATM, public computer area, meeting spaces, and Service Center
- **Lower level:** Community kitchen, laundry room, filtered water and ice machine, and game room with pool table, ping pong, and TVs

Other important things to note:

- No room service.
- No wake-up calls.
- Your room payment is strictly for the room rental.
- Check-in time is 3:00 p.m. or later and check-out time is 11:00 a.m. or earlier.
- Flexible dining plan options are available at an additional cost to the host department or guest, as University Conference Services does not provide them.

Payment Methods

- Full payment is required at the time of check-in. No exceptions.
- MSU's Residence Education and Housing Services department maintains cashless operations within their Service Centers. Service Centers accept credit and debit cards only. Credit cards accepted include American Express, Discover, MasterCard, and Visa. Please make sure to process your payment at Owen Hall only.

- Guests may charge to their host department's university account.
