- 3. Click on the CREATE button on the upper right-hand side.
- 4. Select Upload video. YouTube supports the following formats:

- 6. Fill out the Video Details page:
 - a. Specify a title using the following format:

Trailblazers2022, Student's Last Name and Initial, Name of Trailblazer, Artistic Medium Used Example: Trailblazers2022, Smith, A., Vera Rubin, Dance

- b. Description: Tell us what your video is about, and what inspired you to choose this artistic medium
- c. Thumbnail: select a still from the video or upload your own image
- d. Playlists: N/A
- e. Audience: Select "Yes, it's made for kids". Learn more about what is considered "made for kids" here: <u>https://support.google.com/youtube/answer/9528076?hl=en</u>
- 7. Complete settings on the right panel:
